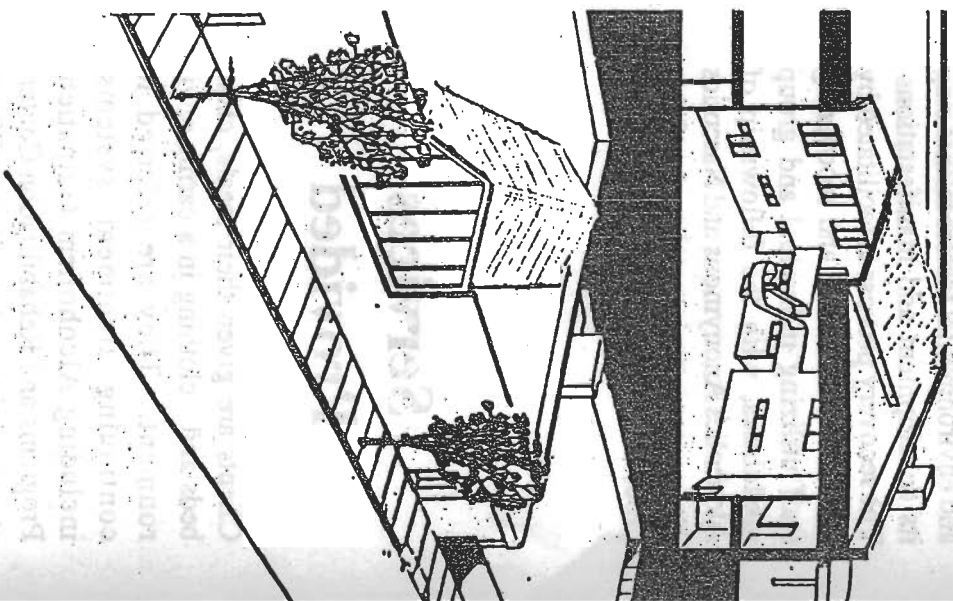

Faith Mission Alcohol Crisis Center, Inc. is a nonmedical inpatient detoxification facility. It operates on the philosophy that Alcoholism is a treatable disease with genetic, psychological, emotional, spiritual and environmental factors influencing its development and manifestations. The recovery process is facilitated by both non-recovering and recovering staff utilizing individual and group modalities, with the fellowship of Alcoholics Anonymous and Narcotics Anonymous, as integral tools of this process.

## Services Provided

Clients are given their meals, clean beds and clothing in a caring environment. They are referred to continuing treatment systems, including Alcoholism Outpatient Programs and Rehabilitation Centers so as to maintain their sobriety. Efforts will be made to obtain entitlements when indicated.

## Length Of Stay

The length of a client's stay at the center is 3 to 14 days; however, this may vary according to the situation of the individual client, e.g.: awaiting a bed for a long-term treatment facility.



## Eligibility

Clients must be over the age of 18 and must be evaluated as clinically appropriate. If a client is using other drugs besides alcohol, he or she must have a history of alcoholism or alcohol abuse to be admitted. Persons are admitted on a voluntary presentation basis. Alcohol intoxication is determined by a positive alco-meter reading and/or indications of alcohol withdrawal. We accept both male and female clients without regard to race, religion or national origin.

## Medical Assessment

This will consist of past medical history, vital signs and evaluation of withdrawal symptoms to determine if client is appropriate for nonmedical detoxification. The withdrawal process is monitored by nurses, other medical personnel, and counselors, in a safe environment.

## Counseling / Referrals

Individual and group counseling is the core of treatment. Referrals to other levels of treatment is our goal.

## Hours

Faith Mission Alcohol Crisis Center is a 24-hour, 7-day a week facility.

## Fees

Faith Mission Alcohol Crisis Center charges no fees.
